Chronology : Life of Don Bosco

World: 1814, Stevenson invents the steam locomotive

Japan: 1815, reign of Tokugawa lenari, 11th Tokugawa Shogun

16 August 1815, John Bosco is born in Becchi, Piemont region in the Kingdom of Saldegna

1817(1 year old), Giovannni's father dies of an acute illness. His mother Margaret is left with 3 boys under her care. They are too poor to send him to school.

World: 1821, Napolion dies.

- **1824(9 years old)**, Sees the prophetic dream that indicates his calling in life.
- World: 1830, the Revolution of July in France
- 1831~35(16~20 years old), boarding in Chieri, studies in highschool while taking jobs to support himself.
- 1835~41(20~25), studies at the seminary in Chieri for priesthood
- **1841(25 years old)**, ordained Catholic priest. People call him "Don Bosco(Fr. Bosco)". Encounters boys who live

in the streets of Turin and starts the Oratory.

- **1843(28 years old)**, starts evening classes for young workers. The Oratory moves from place to place.
- 1846(31 years old) April, Rents the Pinardi House in Valdocco, Turin. The Oratory settles in Valdocco. In July, Don Bosco becomes critically ill from overwork, takes a long time for recovery at his home in Becchi. Returns to the Oratory with his mother Margaret.
- 1847(32 years old), starts a boarding house for orphaned boys.
- 1853(38 years old), starts trade school with workshops and printing shops. Begins to publishes the monthly magazine "Catholic Lectures".
- **1854(39 years old),** proposes the founding of the Salesian Society to 4 youths. The outbreak of cholera epidemic in Turin in the summer, the boys of the Oratory volunteer to take care of the sick.
- 1857(42 years old), Dominic Savio dies at the age of 15 (canonized in 1954).

World: 1859, War of Independence of Italy(~60)

- **1859(44 years old),** with 17 members, most of them former students of the Oratory, founding of the Salesian Society which dedicates itself for the salvation of youths.
- 1860(45 years old), his former student Michele Rua becomes the first priest ordained as a Salesian (Rua becomes 2nd Rector Major in 1888, succeeding Don Bosco)
 World: 1861, Kingdom of Italy erected; the American Civil War (~ 65)

Japan: 1868, Meiji Restoration begins

- **1868(53 years old),** the Basilica of Mary Help of Christians is completed and dedicated.
- **1872(57 years old),** founding of the Daughters of Mary Auxiliatrix, the Salesian Sisters.
- **1875(60 years old),** sending of 1st missionary expedition to Argentine, South America. The leader of the group is Fr. Giovannni Cagliero who later becomes a cardinal.

1876(61 years old), founding of the Salesiani Cooperatori, of whose members live the Salesian spirit in secular society.

31 January 1888(72 years old), returns to his Father's home in Heaven

* * *

- **1926,** Fr. Cimatti and 8 Salesian missionaries arrive in Japan.
- 1929, 6 Salesian Sisters arrive in Japan.
- **1934,** the Catholic Church proclaims Don Bosco Saint.
- **1937,** Caritas Sisters of Jesus is founded in Miyazaki by Fr. Cimatti and Fr. Cavoli
- 2015, Celebration of the Bicentenary of Don Bosco's Birth. The Salesian Family is present in more than 130 countries all over the world. More than 400,000 members belonging to 30 groups serve the youth and the poor in various settings: schools, parishes and social works, etc.

ついに……ドン・ボスコが漫画になりました。皆さん、いかがでしたか?

今年2015年はドン・ボスコがこの世に生まれて200周年ということで、い ろいろな形でお祝いが行われています。この漫画は、特に現代に生きる若者の 皆さんに、ドン・ボスコの精神をわかりやすい形で伝えて、その精神を新たに したいという思いから生まれたものです。

ドン・ボスコの人生は72年、渡瀬方丈で、これを1冊の漫画にまとめること はかなり困難なことでした。この漫画の目的を考え、わかりやすくまとめた形 で伝えるために、時には史実とは厳密な意味では異なる部分もありますが、ド ン・ボスコの根本的な人物像やメッセージについては誤解が生まれないよう細 心の注意を払っています。

また、単にドン・ボスコの歴史物語を伝えるのではなく、現代の若者が彼と 出会うという物語にしました。リクとマナという二人の高校生が時代と国を 超 えてドン・ボスコと出会う。最初は戸惑いを感じながらも少しずつ変わってい く二人の姿に、きっと読者の皆さんは共感するのではないかなと思っています。 読んでくれた皆さんが、この二人を通してドン・ボスコに出会い、彼とオラトリ オのみんなの生き方を知って、何か大切なことに気づいてくれたら、最高です。

ドン・ボスコは、19世紀のイタリア・トリノという舞台の中で、その時いち ばん助けを必要としていた若者たちから目をそらさずに、彼らのために自分の 一生をかけました。しかも、若者が若者らしく、元気いっぱいに楽しく過ごし ながら神様に向かって進めるような新しいやり方で取り組んでいったのです。 そのスタイルが、おそらく今でも世界中で多くの若者を惹きつけている魅力に なっていると思います。そしてこの漫画を読んだ皆さんも、そんなドン・ボス コの魅力に強く引き寄せられるのを感じるのではないでしょうか。

ドン・ボスコの働きは、彼の晩年から世界に広がり始め、現在では130以上 の国で「サレジオ会」というカトリック修道会の働きとして、また彼のスタイル を受け継ぐ「サレジオ家族」と呼ばれる30のグループの働きとして続けられて います。日本ではサレジオ会、サレジアン・シスターズ、イエスのカリタス修 道女会、サレジアーニ・コオペラトーリ、ドン・ボスコ女子在俗会(VDB)、 株 助者聖マリアの会(ADMA)、扶助者聖母会同窓会(ウニオーネ)、サレジオ同窓 会連合の8つのグループが活動しています。

最後になりましたが、この漫画はドン・ボスコの心を伝えたい仲間たち皆の 共同作業で完成しました。企画当時の日本管区長として漫画出版を激励してく ださった故アルド・チプリアニ神父。現日本管区長の山野内倫昭神父。漫画家 の鈴木ぐりさん、漫画編集者のスタイル株式会社 蒲笛雅子さん、背景担当のま がみばんさん、DTP 担当の石田毅さん。「算谷義樹神父はじめドン・ボスコ社編 集部の皆さん。貴重なアドバイスをくださった皆さん。本当にありがとうござ いました。

この漫画を通して多くの人がドン・ボスコを好きなり、ひいてはイエス様を 好きになってくれることを願っています。


